Make sure your passport is up to date. Your passport must have at least 6 months validity remaining from the day you arrive in Israel. No visas are necessary for individuals with U.S. or Canadian passports. Shots are also not required. Keep your passport with you at all times and keep a photocopy of it with your luggage should it get lost.

If you do not have a passport, you must apply for one from your county clerk's office or post office. This process may take approximately 6 weeks. Those wishing to receive their passports sooner may request expedited service, which assures receipt within 7-10 days depending upon location. Travelers with proof of a more urgent departure date should apply in person at a Passport Agency.

1. Proof of U.S. Citizenship
 - a. Most recent U.S. Passport
 - b. Certified copy of birth certificate
 - c. Naturalization citizenship certificate (report of birth abroad)
 - d. If none of the above are available, contact the passport acceptance facility for help

2. Passport Photos

- a. Two duplicate, recently taken (within 6 months)
- b. Full-Face, plain light, white background - 2" X 2"
- c. These photos can be obtained at most camera shops and photography studios with no wait at a reasonable price
